## VISIT TO THE MEDIEVAL MARKETS OF DOLENJSKA

**The programme includes:** 4x overnight stays in a double room with local providers, 4x breakfast, 3x dinner, 1x lunch, 2x bike rental, 1x boat rental and equipment, luggage transfer, itineraries, maps, organisation, entrance fees (agricultural museum, Mirna Castle, Žužemberk Castle)

**Additional fees:** insurance, transfer to the departure and destination points, bathing at the Dolenjske Toplice Health Resort

DAY 1: Šentjernej—Šmarješke Toplice, hiking 24 km

Hike towards Šmarješke Toplice following arrival. Visit to Gutenwert, Škocjan, Zagraški log, Klevevž. Bathing in the swimming pools. Lunch.



DAY 2: Šmarješke Toplice—Mokronog/Mirna, cycling 24/40 km

Bicycle pick-up after breakfast and ride towards Mokronog or Mirna. Visit to the Radulja Valley, agricultural museum, Church of St. Peter, Žalostna gora, Mokronog (Šentrupert, Vesela gora, Mirna Castle). Dinner and overnight stay.

DAY 3: Mokronog/Mirna—Žužemberk, cycling 54/38 km

Ride past Šentrupert, Vesela gora, Mirna Castle, Čatež, Jurjeva Homestead and Baraga's birth house to Žužemberk. Dinner and overnight stay.



DAY 4: Žužemberk, sculling 14 km

Following breakfast, transfer to Zagradec and raft descent to Žužemberk or Dvor. Visit to the Tuft thresholds. Transfer to Žužemberk, dinner and overnight stay.

DAY 5: Žužemberk—Dolenjske Toplice, hiking 17 km

Hike to Dolenjske Toplice past Nara's cross, Auersperg iron foundry, Marjana Marinca Museum, Devil's Tower and TMS Bistra museum collection (for groups). Bathing in the swimming pools.
